

Redi Help Employee Agreement

Please keep your phone number and email address up to date with us.

I certify that the hours entered, including overtime, lunch and break times, are correct and that the work was completed within the week indicated by me. I understand that this timecard must be approved by the client for my paycheck to be issued. I understand that I will need to return any borrowed uniform or equipment items before I can receive my paycheck. I agree to contact Redi Help at the end of each assignment; otherwise, Redi Help may assume that I am not available. Leaving an assignment during my assigned shift, or not reporting for an assignment as scheduled is an indication to Redi Help that I have voluntarily quit my employment with Redi Help. I also understand that to be considered for other work, I should contact Redi Help when an assignment has ended. Failure to contact Redi Help will be considered a voluntary departure from employment and unemployment benefits could be denied as result. I agree to report any on the job work related injuries as soon as possible. If I received a draw against my pay, bus tickets, or have been charged with transportation fee/s I agree that this/these will be deducted from my pay.

I understand that Redi Help is committed to maintaining a safe working environment for all employees. Due to the nature of temporary assignments, workplace hazards will vary. Prior to starting your shift, ask the client job site supervisor for a safety briefing including any safety equipment requirements. I agree to follow all safety related instructions given to me either by Redi Help or the job site client manager, including employing all appropriate safety equipment. If I am ever asked to do anything unsafe, observe unsafe working conditions, or are injured at work, I will contact Redi Help immediately. Failure to follow safety instructions or employ appropriate safety equipment could result in immediate termination. Furthermore, I agree to perform all work in as safe a manner as possible. When in doubt, ASK! If I experience an accident or injury while working for Redi Help, I will notify Redi Help immediately. To fail to do so within 48 hours could result in immediate termination.
